

There is some hay starting to move as most farmers are saying it has just taken a lot to get through this year due to a dry fall which started feeding early and the extreme cold lately. Demand for small loads of horse hay in small square bales is also very good. Water supplies continue to be a major concern in the southern areas of the state as several reports of farmers everything but just out of water.
