

Missouri Weekly Hay Summary 02/01/19

The last week of Missouri has been dangerously cold. At least for the short term, mud has frozen up. The arrival of February, however, is supposed to bring temperatures that will bring back the mud. Hay feeding has been at max levels as producers work to keep livestock healthy and alive. Hay business is about the same story as has been stated the last month or so.
