

# **Missouri Crop Progress and Condition 11/04/19**

Temperatures last week averaged 40.2 degrees, 12.4 degrees below normal. Precipitation averaged 1.15 inches statewide, 0.06 inches above normal. There were 3.2 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending November 3, 2019. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 1 percent short, 78 percent adequate, and 21 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 2 percent short, 89 percent adequate, and 9 percent surplus. Corn harvested for grain progressed to 71 percent, 21 percentage points behind last year. Soybeans dropping leaves progressed to 97 percent, while soybean harvested progressed to 54 percent this week, 8 percentage points behind last year. Soybean condition was rated at 4 percent very poor, 11 percent poor, 26 percent fair, 52 percent good, and 7 percent excellent. Cotton harvested progressed to 60 percent, 31 percentage points behind last year. Winter wheat planted progressed to 55 percent this week, while winter wheat emerged progressed to 33 percent. Winter wheat condition was rated at 1 percent very poor, 5 percent poor, 50 percent fair, 43 percent good, and 1 percent excellent.
