

There were 5.2 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending November 17, 2019. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 3 percent short, 87 percent adequate, and 10 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 3 percent short, 90 percent adequate, and 7 percent surplus. Corn harvested for grain progressed to 85 percent, 10 percentage points behind last year. Soybean harvested progressed to 83 percent this week, 7 percentage points ahead of last year. Cotton harvested progressed to 86 percent, 10 percentage points behind last year. Winter wheat planted progressed to 87 percent this week, 6 percentage points ahead of last year, while winter wheat emerged progressed to 68 percent. Winter wheat condition was rated at 2 percent very poor, 7 percent poor, 49 percent fair, 40 percent good, and 2 percent excellent.
