

Farmers found themselves dealing with muddy nasty conditions after a warm up following heavy rains, flash flooding and snow last weekend. Another front expected over the next few days and a big dip in temperatures early next week should finally freeze the ground which many hope will last a while. Final year in production numbers were released late last week and confirmed what most of us knew. Missouri made a lot of hay last year! Ending 2019 stocks were higher than any state in nation up nearly 65% from the very difficult year of 2018. The supply of hay is moderate to heavy, demand is light to moderate and prices are steady.
