

Although there was still some left-over snow in the north early week, for the first week in quite a while there was no new winter weather this week. Mud is still a problem, especially in the afternoons. With February quickly passing, many are now taking counts of inventory on hand and starting to make plans for fertilizer and spring work for the upcoming growing season. Hay movement is slow.
