

There was quite a bit of equipment cutting in anhydrous over the weekend and several buggies out spreading fertilizer, as well. Several gooseneck loads of round bales were spotted on the roads this week and quite a few listings being added as producers are trying to move any extra inventory before new crop hay arrives.
