

Missouri Crop Progress and Condition 4/20/20

April 24, 2020

Temperatures last week averaged 43.5 degrees, 12.7 degrees below normal. Precipitation averaged 0.89 inches statewide, 0.04 inches below normal. There were 3.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending April 19, 2020. Topsoil moisture supply was rated 1 percent short, 72 percent adequate, and 27 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supply was rated 76 percent adequate and 24 percent surplus. Corn planted progressed to 11 percent this week, 2 percentage points behind last year. Rice planted progressed to 8 percent, 13 percentage points behind last year. Winter wheat headed progressed to 2 percent this week, 1 percentage point ahead of last year. Winter wheat condition was rated at 2 percent very poor, 7 percent poor, 41 percent fair, 44 percent good, and 6 percent excellent.
